
The Oldham County Fire Instructors Association notified the Frankfort Regional Office of the construction of a fire training facility located at 3711 West Highway 146 in Buckner, Kentucky. The structure is constructed of concrete and steel and the dimensions are 24' x 36'. Only Class A materials consistent with NFPA 1403 requirements will be burned in the structure.

The Kentucky Division for Air Quality approved bonafide fire training that meets the safety standards and procedures by the Kentucky State Fire Marshal, the Kentucky Fire Commission, or the National Wildlife Coordinating Group.

As part of the voluntary Do Your Share for Cleaner Air program, your consideration of rescheduling if there is a smog alert on the day of a training exercise would be greatly appreciated.
